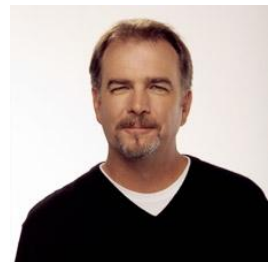
Friday, November 13, 2010, 8 p.m. Comedy Night at Buffalo Thunder with Bill Engvall

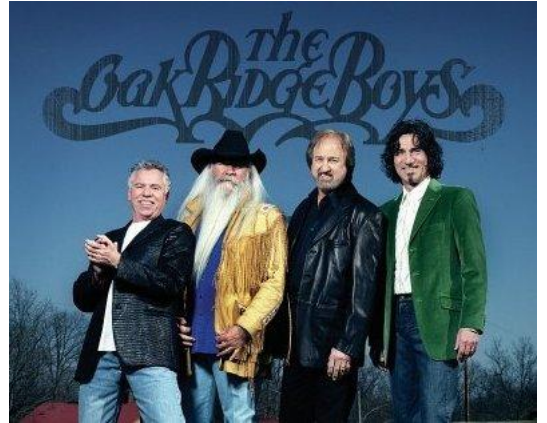
